

AGAPE TOURS - KENYA SAFARI 2020

SAT October 10th 2020 - Day 1: Arrival in Nairobi

JAMBO - KARIBU!! On arrival in Nairobi, you will be met at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport by Pita Safaris representatives who will warmly meet you, greet you and assist you with the transfer to Sarova Panafric Hotel.

Overnight: Sarova Panafric Hotel

Meal Plan: Bed and Breakfast

SUN11/10 - Day 2: Nairobi to Aberdare National Park

After breakfast enjoy game drive en-route departing to the Aberdare National Park. Arrive for lunch at Aberdare Country Club then you'll be transferred to the tree house for dinner and overnight. Game is viewed while relaxing at the lodge cabins and the balcony as they frequent the water-hole. Animals that may be sighted from the lodge include rhino, elephant, buffalo, lion, bushbuck, waterbuck and other species.

MON12/10 - Day 3: Nairobi to Aberdare National Park

On this day after breakfast, you will leave the lodge with a packed picnic lunch accompanied by an armed ranger for a whole day trekking tour. You will trek through the moorland, viewing the beautiful hills, valleys, waterfalls, and the wildlife.

TUE 13/10 & WED 14 /10 - Day 4 & 5 : Aberdare National Park to Samburu Game Reserve

After breakfast, transfer to the Outspan for onward journey north to Samburu National Reserve. Game viewing drives in Samburu land for the next two days. The Samburu area harbours a number of wildlife species rarely found elsewhere, the unique Samburu Five - Beisa oryx, reticulated giraffe, Grevy's zebra, long-necked gerenuk and the Somali ostrich. Other animals to be seen wildlife include elephant, lion, leopard, cheetah, buffalos, Grant's gazelle, dik diks and waterbuck. There are over 350 varieties of birds including kingfisher, humming birds, eagles, vultures, hornbills, falcons, Egyptian geese and guinea fowl. The entire Samburu region is a place of breath-taking and magical beauty, a place where the vision of a deep red sunset silhouetting the doum palms along the Ewaso Nyiro River. Other optional activities include; camel walks, guided bush walks, bird watching, river bed walks and cultural village visits.

THU 15/10 & FRI 16 /10 - Day 6 & 7: Samburu Game Reserve to Ol Pejeta Conservancy

After breakfast depart to Ol Pejeta Conservancy for two days game viewing drives, short game viewing enroute to your Sweetwater's Serena **Tented** Camp arriving in time for lunch then relax until afternoon tea is served. Later in the afternoon, proceed on an afternoon game viewing drive within the reserve. Upon returning to camp join other guests for a drink around the campfire or in the cosy lounge tent where you will join your hosts for dinner. The Ol Pejeta Conservancy with 90,000 acres of wilderness is home to Kenya's largest population of Black Rhino, large numbers of elephant, cheetah, lion, leopard, African wild dog and plentiful plains game. There are also a number of the rarer Northern species such as Grevy's Zebra, Jackson's Hartebeest and Beisa Oryx. While in Ol Pejeta, you can visit the Morani Center and the endangered species enclosure with the last remaining Northern White Rhinos on the planet, the chimpanzee's sanctuary, or pay a visit to the anti-poaching dogs (some activities at a fee). Other optional activities on offer include lion tracking, canoeing, horse riding, and mountain biking and bush walks.

Overnight: Sweetwaters Serena Tented Camp

Meal Plan: Full Board

SAT 17/10 - Day 8: Ol Pejeta Sweetwaters to Lake Nakuru National Park

After breakfast at your camp depart with game drive en route to Lake Nakuru National Park, a great ornithological spectacle on earth and a home to thousands of flamingoes. Arrive in time for lunch at the Lake Nakuru Lodge, which enjoys sweeping views across the lake followed by an afternoon game drive. Lake Nakuru National Park provides a sanctuary for the endangered black and white rhino as well as the Rothschild's Giraffe. Other animals include eland, lion, warthogs, zebras, leopard, grants, gazelle, waterbuck, impala, hyena, dik dik, buffalo, giraffe, aardvark and baboon, numerous plains game and 450 species of birds.

Overnight: Lake Nakuru Lodge

Meal Plan: Full Board

SUN 18/10 - Day 9: Lake Nakuru National Park to Lake Bogoria

After breakfast depart Lake Nakuru to Lake Bogoria for a day excursion arriving in good time to explore on the foot the natural lake, the hot springs geysers, caution must be observed while walking close to the hot springs as these are super-hot and the park is also known for the viewing of Flamingos in their thousands. Later you will return back to Nakuru town and overnight.

Overnight: Sarova Woodlands Hotel

Meal Plan: Full Board

MON 19/10 & TUE 20/10 - Day 10 & 11: Lake Nakuru National Park to Masai Mara National Reserve

Enjoy an early breakfast and depart for the Maasai Mara National Reserve offering wonderful scenery and plenty of game. You will arrive at the Mara Sopa Lodge in time for lunch and rest. This afternoon you will depart for an exciting game viewing drive. You will spend the next two days with morning & afternoon game drives on the rolling plains and grasslands, stretching far into the horizons as far as the eye can see. Maasai Mara National Reserve is home to the black-maned lion, the savannah elephant, the Cape buffalo,

wildebeests, the elusive leopard, cheetah, the spotted & striped hyena, the rhino, topi, burchelle's zebra, the Masai giraffe among many others. Optional Activities include bush breakfast, sun-downers and a visit to the traditional Masai Manyatta (off the beaten track) to experience the culture of this world famous community. The Masai still live as they did for centuries -interact with these nomadic people and experience their way of life as you learn about their customs and traditions.

Optional activity: Balloon Safari over the Mara plains followed by a champagne breakfast.

Overnight: Mara Sopa Lodge

Meal Plan: Full Board

WED 21 & THU 22 /10 - Day 12 & 13: Masai Mara National Reserve to Lake Naivasha

This morning we enjoy our breakfast then check-out departing to Lake Naivasha arriving in time for lunch and spend the afternoon at leisure. On the next day it will be at leisure and a boat ride on Lake Naivasha where we explore the fresh water rift valley lake witnessing the prolific variety of bird-life on the lake and the lake shore and the afternoon is spend on a guided walk around the Crater lake.

Please note that the boat ride will depend on the tides at the time. Please also wear comfortable clothes and walking shoes, sunscreen and a hat or cap.

Overnight: Naivasha Sopa Lodge

Meal Plan: Full Board.

FRI 23/10 - Day 14: Lake Naivasha to Nairobi

This morning after breakfast it will be a guided walking safari at the Crescent Island and then come back in time for buffet lunch at Elsamere Gardens then drive back to Nairobi. In the evening you will enjoy dinner at the famous Carnivore restaurant. We will then transfer you to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO) for your departure flight back home.
